Is an essay required for all decision options? Yes, 150 lines which is a supplement to the Common Admission app. Do not repeat what is in the application – list activities, passion, family responsibilities, part-time job – what defines you.

Are letters of Recommendation required or suggested? Yes, one from counsellor and 2 from teachers

Is an in-person interview required or suggested? Not required, but is conducted by local area Alumni.
