Does chosen major affect decision process? Yes, must audition for Music, Dance, and Art; portfolio for Film

Study Abroad Programs? Summer Programs, Semester-Long Programs, Foreign Language Programs? 20+ study centers around the world. Year-round campuses in London, Florence, Panama City, and Valencia.

Internships / Co-Op Opportunities? Depends on major. Some require it.

Research Opportunities? Yes, even available to Freshman, not limited to "hard" sciences

Special successes the school is known for: 93% retention rate and 79% graduation rate places FSU among the Top 30 Public Institutions in the US

Scholarships: Are there any specific to our area or for Georgia students? limited number of merit based including 100% out-of-state tuition reduction and 50% tuition reduction

When are scholarship deadlines? Admitted students are automatically considered for merit based scholarships. It is best to apply before Oct 15 deadline. Approximately 91% of incoming freshman receive some type of merit based or need based scholarship. Merit based scholarship \$9600 split over 4 years.
