When are application deadlines? Different decisions:

Early Decision is binding the deadline is Nov 15th the deadline for Early Decision II is January 15th Early Action is Dec 1st these students are considered for scholarships

Regular Decision deadline is February 1st

Is an essay required for all decision options? Yes, included on admission criteria.

Are letters of Recommendation required or suggested? Yes, one from a counselor and one from a teacher. Teachers should speak out for help sought etc., showing focus and commitment.

Is an in-person interview required or suggested? Not required but recommend reaching out during a college visit, appointments are available.

How many applicants are received per year? 2977 applicants with 40% admission rate. 92% retention rate

How much is the application fee? Free
