



MOWR Program at Georgia State University Perimeter College:

- 1) Meet with your high school counselor regarding your plans. Complete the “Move On When Ready Student Participation Agreement” with your parents and high school counselor.
- 2) Review eligibility below:
 - a) Must be a high school junior or senior.
 - b) Must have a 3.0 unweighted core GPA as calculated by GSU Perimeter College.
 - c) Must have either eligible SAT or ACT scores:

 - c) Follow the prompts to complete the college application.
- 4) Deadlines for application:
 - a) Fall Semester – July 1st
 - b) Spring Semester – November 1st
 - c) Summer Semester – April 1st
 - d) Please note that some high schools impose different application deadlines.
- 5) Submit required documents to the Enrollment and Registration Office at one of the GSU Perimeter College locations.
 - a) Official High School Transcript
 - b) Official SAT or ACT Scores
 - c) Immunization Records (<http://depts.gpc.edu/immunizations/immunizationcertificate.pdf>)
 - d) Parental Consent Form
 - e) Verification of Lawful Presence (Driver’s License, U.S. Passport, Birth Certificate)

- 7) Your MOWR Coordinator will offer academic guidance, including, math placement, and will review the Move On When Ready Funding Option. Contact us for an appointment once you have been admitted to the program at GSU Perimeter College. Orientation will be addressed at the appointment.

I understand that applications and admissions documents are due to GSU Perimeter College on July 1 for Fall semester, November 1 for Spring semester, and April 1 for Summer semester. GSU Perimeter College will make every effort to accommodate applications or documents received after the due dates, but cannot guarantee admission for timely registration for that semester.

I understand that until ALL required admissions documents have been received by GSU Perimeter College, and admission must be confirmed on <http://www.gpc.edu/mystatus>, before my child will be able to register for and attend any GSU Perimeter College class, including GSU Perimeter College classes held at high school locations.

I understand that Move On When Ready is a program that allows a high school student early access to the collegiate experience, which may be very different from the high school environment. Georgia State University Perimeter College will consider my child as an adult college student, and all rules, regulations, policies and procedures of Georgia State University Perimeter College and the University System of Georgia will apply to my child, exactly as they would apply to any other student of Georgia State University Perimeter College.

I understand that my child, while registered as a Move On When Ready student at Georgia State University Perimeter College, will be treated as the OWNER of his/her educational records, and that Georgia State University Perimeter College will act as the CUSTODIAN of those records. Under the terms of the Family Educational Records and Privacy Act (FERPA), I will not have access to those records, nor be able to receive any protected information regarding those records from Georgia State University Perimeter College without the expressed written consent of my child for the release of only that information requested in each **individual written consent**. Move On When Ready Student Participation Agreement

The Move On When Ready (MOWR) program provides opportunities for eligible students in grades 9-12 to enroll part- or full-time in postsecondary institutions and take college courses to earn both high school and college credit. Effective July 1, 2015, the Move On When Ready program combines all previous Georgia dual-credit programs into one program entitled Move On When Ready, repealing all conflicting laws.
